



Who is Bob Ivory?

For 35 years, the St. Joe's Alumni Association has organized the Annual Bob Ivory Run to honor him for his contributions to the school and local community.

Bob Ivory, a Greater Buffalo Sports Hall of Fame inductee, coached legendary track and cross country teams, volunteered for school functions, supported the St. Joe's mission and dedicated his life to teaching. He also contributed to the Western New York running community both as a coach and as an official.

Many Western New York runners remember Bob's successful St. Joe's track and cross country teams of the 1960s and 1970s, well-known not only for their Monsignor Martin Association championships, but also for their accomplishments at national invitational events. Runners on these teams credit their success to superb conditioning and the tireless effort and commitment of their coach.

Bob remains dedicated to education. He is a former math teacher who donates countless hours and resources to St. Joe's, Canisius College, the Special Olympics and the Empire State Games. For his many contributions to the running community and to St. Joe's, the Alumni Association is proud to once again hold the annual Bob Ivory Run.
