- Erie Community College 480 meter calibration course used.
- Runners have access to the entire road surface to allow for the shortest distance, except Baseline where the road is coned so that runners proceed on the East side of Baseline Road.
- All reference points marked with 2" PK(Parker-Kalon) nails, yellow survey marker washers sprayed with yellow paint.
- It will be the responsibility of the race director to repaint the references each year.

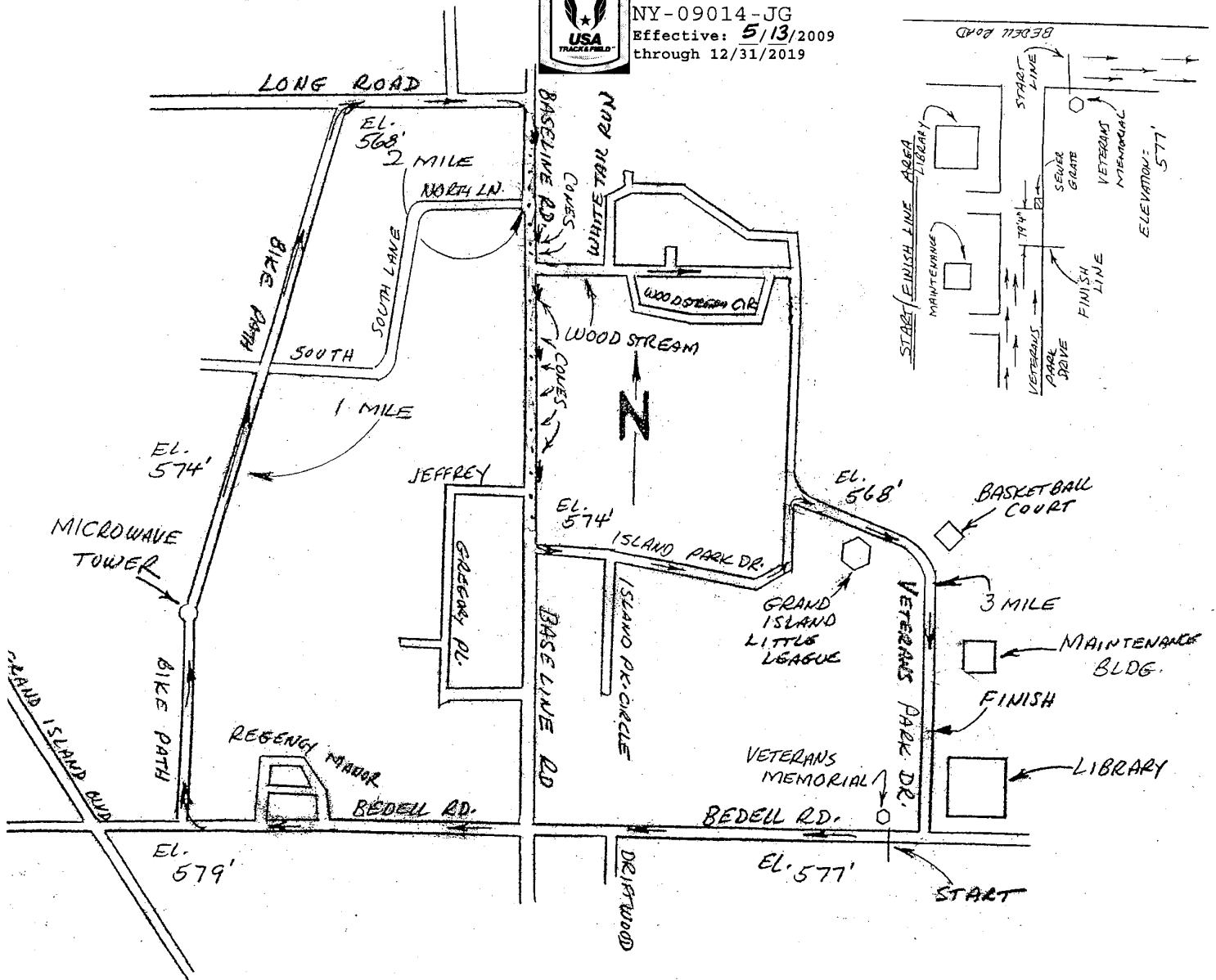
- Start: On Bedell Road near Veterans Park Drive at the Eastern edge of the Veterans Monument.
- Mile 1: 150' past the first "Grand Island Sanitary Sewer" cover past the microwave tower on the paved bike path between Bedell and Long Road.
- Mile 2: On Baseline Road, at the driveway to #3081 Baseline, directly opposite of North Lane.
- Mile 3: 15' past the metal storm sewer grate, just past the driveway to the basketball courts on Veterans Park Drive.
- Finish: 79' 4" before the Northern edge of the metal storm sewer grate on Veterans Park Drive near the Library.
